




#### Central Revocation Action vs. Counterclaim for Revocation

#### Total (Counterclaim for Revocation): 28 cases






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



13 (partial) revocations




- Lack of patentability (61%)Added subject matter (31%)




#### Opposition Division (first instance) in 2023

696 opposition <u>appeal</u> proceedings in 2024 (in which the Board of Appeal made a substantive decision)





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#### German National Revocation Action - revocation rates




Federal Patent Court 567 cases between 2019 - 2024

Federal Court of Justice 255 cases between 2019 - 2024








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#### Comparison of revocation rates at UPC, EPO and FPC






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



